Senior Building Inspector

Reporting to the Chief Building Official, the Senior Building Inspector shall be responsible to perform all functions related to the review of applications submitted for building permit approval and the performance of on-site inspections to ensure compliance with Ontario Building Code Act, Ontario Building Code, and applicable Town by-laws and regulations. The position will be required to consult with various developers, builders, government agencies and the public, as well as interpret codes, standards and regulations to ensure compliance.

The successful candidate possess the following:

- Post-secondary education relating to Construction Engineering or Architectural Technology.
- Building Code qualified in the following categories: Legal, House, Small Buildings, Plumbing All Buildings, Building Services, Structural, Fire Protection, and Detection, Lighting and Power, Large Buildings, and Complex Buildings
- Minimum 5 years' experience in a municipal building department or related experience
- Possession of a valid "G" Driver's License for the Province of Ontario
