Position Overview	Reporting to the Manager of Building Inspections, the Building Inspector – Life Safety is responsible for inspecting construction at selected stages to ensure conformity with approved drawings, specifications, building codes, building permit by-law and other relevant legislation or policies, and ensuring that unauthorized construction is not taking place and applicable legislation is not being contravened.
Responsibilities	<p>The Building Inspector – Life Safety will be responsible for:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Inspecting construction of life safety systems (sprinkler system, fire alarm, standpipe, fire suppression systems) in Part 9 Multi-Residential buildings and Part 9 Industrial, Commercial, Institutional (ICI) buildings to ensure compliance with the Ontario Building Code and Building Code Act, NFPA, Fire Code and approved drawings, relevant legislations, standards and policies.</li><li>Inspecting construction of life safety systems (sprinkler system, fire alarm, standpipe, fire suppression systems) in Part 3 Residential and ICI buildings to ensure compliance with the Ontario Building Code and Building Code Act, NFPA, Fire Code and approved drawings, relevant legislations, standards and policies.</li><li>Writing and issuance of applicable Orders as prescribed in the BCA including Orders to Comply, Stop Work Orders and other Orders as deemed necessary, including follow-up responsibilities.</li><li>Maintaining accurate and up-to-date records of inspections and evidence.</li><li>Preparation of evidence and prosecution briefs on escalated enforcement matters working alongside the City's Legal department.</li><li>Problem solving 'on site' to provide equivalent solutions to achieve compliance to the applied design specifications.</li></ul>
Requirements	<p>The successful applicant will hold a diploma in Architectural/Engineering Technology or equivalent and a minimum of 3 years experience in conducting municipal Life Safety inspections on Part 9 and Part 3 buildings or 5 years of relevant experience with an in-depth knowledge of the Ontario Building Code.
